Subject: Minutes of 2000 Annual Cluster Meeting

1. The 2000 Annual Meeting of the Hunters Green Cluster Association was held on December 5 at the Reston Community Center. The meeting was called to order at 8:07 p.m. by Arthur Hill, President.
2. The minutes of the 1999 Annual Meeting were read and approved.
3. Board Officer reports were presented. The President, Arthur Hill, updated Cluster members on the Sheraton project and the withdrawal of the Heliport application. He reported on playground upgrades, park bench refurbishment, and pavement repairs. John Piper reported on the Trash and Snow Removal contracts. Katharine Hunter reported on the Care of Trees contract and the Back Yard Habitat program. Bill Holmes, Treasurer, reported on year 2000 expenditures and the status of dues collection, which was excellent.
4. Bill Holmes, Treasurer, presented the year 2001 budget, which maintained annual cluster dues at \$673.75. The budget was approved by the membership.
5. Election of Officers. To fill vacancies created by John Piper's retirement and expiration of interim director Bob Deans' term, Amy Brown and Bob Deans were nominated as Directors. As there were no other nominees, a motion was made and approved to elect them by acclamation. Both Amy Brown and Bob Deans were elected to three-year terms.
6. A member comment period followed. Comments included complaints about the Grounds contract, questions about the Board's role in a Reston Association Covenants Review Board matter, a question regarding the removal of a landscaping project from the Strategic Plan and a wide range of opinions on assigned/allocated parking
7. The meeting was adjourned at 9:53 p.m.
