**NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING AND CALL FOR CANDIDATES**

**The annual meeting of the Hunters Green Cluster Association will be held Tuesday, December 3, 2013 at the Reston Community Center Hunters Woods. Doors will open at 7:30 pm, and the meeting will be called to order promptly at 8:00 pm. A full meeting agenda will be distributed to the Cluster on or before November 20, 2013.**

At the annual meeting we will elect two members to the HGC Board of Directors. There will be one term for three years and one term for two years. As discussed at the 2012 annual meeting, the Board Member term cycle had gotten out of sync sometime between 1998 and 2012. Our first step to correct this was the election of Yanni Chryssomitis for a three year term. The 2013 election will sync up the terms according to the Articles of Incorporation going forward.

Community members interested in standing for election at the annual meeting should submit their name and a short bio to the HGC Board no later than 5:00 pm Sunday November 17, 2013. To be eligible to serve on the HGC Board of Directors, interested parties must be resident members of the Cluster and must be members in good standing (e.g. dues must be current and without unresolved covenants violations or other pending matters) as outlined in the Board Members' Code of Conduct.

In addition, community members seeking Board positions should understand serving as a Board member requires:

- (i) An understanding that the Board is required to represent the best interests of the entire Hunters Green Cluster community, not constituencies or special interest groups.
- (ii) The ability to think and make decisions on a community level.
- (iii) The ability to work effectively within a group.
- (iv) The ability to understand and comply with any/all State and Federal laws governing Common Interest Community Boards (HOA's), Reston Association, and Hunters Green Cluster rules and policies applicable to Board procedure and conduct, and recognized Common Interest Community best practices.

Interested parties should be prepared, if elected, to allocate 10-20 hours per week to Board work. Please note that nominations can be made from the floor, however, it will better serve the community if all nominees submit their intention to run for office by November 17.
