



Hunters Green Cluster Association Committee Charter

2018 Playground Committee

Background

In recent years, the Cluster has made some investments to improve our playground facilities, focusing on the main playground area on Indian Ridge Road. The Board is chartering a committee which can determine what possibilities to update the playground facilities on Hunters Green Court. Additionally, benches across the whole cluster (both Indian Ridge Road and Hunters Green Court) are not in good shape and we need to determine a replacement/refurbishment strategy for those assets.

Goals

The goal of the Playground committee will be to make final recommendations to the Board about what to do with adding or replacing playground equipment on Hunters Green Court and to replace or refurbish the benches on both Hunters Green Court and Indian Ridge Road.

Responsibilities

The specific scope of responsibilities of the Landscaping Committee include, but are not limited to:

- Determine what options are available both for playground equipment and the benches,
- Gather and incorporate feedback from the community,
- Hold regular meetings with community members and liaison Board members,
- Solicit bids and site plans for options consistent with anticipated funding,
- Report back progress at each of the regular Board meetings, and
- Provide a final recommendation to the Board on how to address the playground needs on Hunters Green Court and the benches across the entire Cluster at the November 2018 meeting (any recommendation will be ultimately approved by Reston Association's Design Review Board).

Members

The playground committee will consist of Cluster members in good standing and a Board liaison. The regular committee meetings will be run by the Board liaison or a delegate, as appropriate. Members of the committee may volunteer to be tasked with action items to be researched in between regular committee/Board of Director Meetings.

Conduct and Term of Charter

The conduct and authority of all Cluster Committees are defined in our governing documents. It should be noted that all Committees work at the pleasure of the Board of Directors, and in no way delegates the Board's authority or allows a committee member to make any fiduciary or any other commitment on behalf of Hunters Green Cluster.

The Board expects that the work for this Committee will be concluded in 2018 and the Committee will serve in that capacity through December 31, 2018. This charter may be changed, amended, extended or terminated as appropriately resolved by the Board of Directors.
