



Concrete Schedule & Parking Options Update

No-map Version of Concrete Scheduling

It has come to our attention that some people were unable to locate or to read the map showing the schedule for concrete work. Here is the same information without the map:

Indian Ridge Road	Dates
Houses at the very top of IRR (odds), #769 to 799	Sept. 18-19
Moving down IRR, first parking area to left (evens), #758 to 798	Sept. 18-19
Second parking area to left, (evens) # 722 to 756	Sept. 18-19
Third parking area to left (evens) #700 to 720	Sept. 29 th & 30 th
Parking area to right (odds) closest to Sunrise Valley, #701 to 717	Oct. 4
Curbs and sidewalks along IRR	Oct. 5-6, 9

If you live on the main roadway, please pay attention to signs that will be announcing work areas – general work will begin at the top of IRR and work down.

Hunters Green Court	Dates
Houses at the bottom, farthest from entrance	Oct. 10-11
Rest of HGC	Oct. 16-20

Please pay attention to signs that will be announcing work areas. Generally the work on HGC will start further from the entrance and move up. You will only need to move your car when they reach your area, but if there is a question as to whether they will reach you on a particular day, please move the car. You don't want to take a chance of having it towed. We will try to be more specific with signs as the work gets underway.

As a reminder, cars in an active area must be moved during work hours, 7 am to 7pm.

PARKING OPTIONS: We have obtained a few options for temporarily displaced cars. *We ask that if you have multiple cars and are able to do so, to make other arrangements with friends and family for secondary and tertiary vehicles allowing more of the community to utilize off-site parking.* For all options except the paid parking at the Sheraton, please be aware that the parking owners are not responsible for any loss or damage. We are strongly recommending that residents print out the parking pass on the last page of this packet when parking in any of the office parking lots or the golf course. Fill in your phone number and place it so that it is clearly visible on your dashboard.

1906 Association Drive (DAY and NIGHT parking – Parking Pass Recommended): Of the parking options available, the most commodious is at 1906 Association Drive, the Council for Teachers of Mathematics. This association has generously offered the use of up to 60 spaces during the day and 98 spaces at night. If more than 60 cars need so park overnight, they should not park until after working hours end and depart before they begin. This means parking after 5:30 pm and departing around 7:30 am. If you turn right onto Association Drive at the light, this building is the first on the left.

UPDATE: The Council for Teachers of Mathematics have 2 important requests that we need you to honor: 1) that we park at the rear of their lot (that area closest to Association Dr), leaving spaces closer to the building for their staff (staff are there as early as 7 am and as late as 7 pm); and 2) to NOT use their handicap spaces. Our cooperation is important so please make note of these requests!!

Reston National Golf Course (Overnight Parking Only – Parking Pass Recommended): We also have been told that we can use the golf course for overnight parking (7 pm to 6:30 am). Please keep in mind that there are no lights and no security at the golf course – please use common sense and caution if you park your vehicle here.

Hartke Building (Overnight Parking Only – Parking Pass Recommended): The Hartke building is located at the corner of Sunrise Valley and Reston Parkway. They have offered the use of their lot for overnight parking.

Sheraton Hotel (Day and Overnight Parking): The Sheraton offers airport parking for \$6/day for up to 2 weeks at a time. This is covered parking (website is incorrect) and your vehicle will be accessible 24/7 if needed. Please visit
